Why am I being asked to give?

- The NATS Framing Our Future Fund is an opportunity to give gifts enabling NATS to meet the greatest needs of the organization.
- Donors may continue to designate their support to a specific fund that supports their specific interests.

Why is this being done? Aren't my membership dues enough to keep NATS in operation?

- Membership dues, earned revenue from advertising, conference and workshop fees, sponsorships, in-kind donations of event space, and thousands of indispensable volunteer hours are essential for the fiscal health of the Association.
- The Framing Our Future Fund will supplement dues and enable NATS to not only continue serving its members, but to thrive in a competitive environment.

Can I make a monthly recurring payment?

- Yes, recurring monthly gifts may be pledged, providing a selection is made for a set contribution level of monthly giving on an ongoing basis.

Is there a minimum amount for annual giving?

- We will accept – and appreciate- your gift at any amount.

I donated with my online membership renewal (via Exware). Will my gift still be counted?

- Gifts made in conjunction with membership renewal are much like gifts that we are asked to make when we renew subscriptions to an arts performance series, underscoring loyalty and appreciation of the excellence of the programs being provided. These gifts are greatly appreciated.
- Gifts made with online membership renewal after January 1 may be counted toward the member's total annual giving each year, potentially increasing the donor's gift recognition level.
- Every member will be asked to make a gift to the NATS Framing Our Future Fund in addition to gifts made with membership renewals each year.
