Stephen Memorial Scholarship is awarded at the National Association of Teachers of Singing (NATS) National Student Auditions (NSAs) for an outstanding performance of a Canadian art song in the college-age classical categories. Named for the founder of the first Canadian NATS chapter, Roberta M. Stephen was part of a musical family from Southern Alberta. She held degrees from the University of North Texas and University of Calgary. Stephen's students were consistent award winners at the local, provincial, and national levels and many former students teach and perform professionally.
