



## Parking Information for the College of Music, at UC-Boulder

[Registration for Students and Attendees will be located at the Imig Music Building Lobby]

The options for parking on campus during the NSA Competitions and for Workshop Attendees are as follows:

### **If you are using Campus Accommodations:**

- You will be staying in **BAKER HALL** during your time on campus.
- Weekly permits (for overnight parking) are available at residence hall front desks for \$20 for **the specified lot/s listed on the permit**. Payment can be made by credit card or check.
- Parking is by permit or credit card pay-to-park machines. Participants are responsible for reading and adhering to all posted parking policies and paying accordingly. Read all signage when entering a lot to ensure you are parking in the correct lot. Individual requirements exist for each lot based on day and time. ### **If you are driving to campus daily to attend the Workshop or Competitions:**

1) Purchase a weekly parking pass at the window of Parking and Transportation Services for \$16. Most likely, it will be in Lot 308, which is not too far from the music building. This rate is much cheaper than using metered parking or parking garage.

Temporary permits are available to campus affiliates and visitors at the Parking and Transportation Services customer service window, 1050 Regent Drive. Date and display these permits when needed. For additional visitor parking options, view our [Visitor Parking page](#).

#### **Cost**

**One day:** \$9

**One week:** \$16

*Pay with Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, check or cash. Temporary permits are not refundable and parking is assigned in lots that PTS knows to be available for temporary periods.*

2) Metered parking around the music building. The cost is \$1.75 per hour.

3) Euclid Auto Park (Public Parking Garage) in front of the music building. The cost is \$2 per hour (1-3 hours)/\$4 per hour (3-10 hours).

3) Free street parking on the other side of Broadway. You must park past Baseline Road for all-day parking. (Otherwise, it's 2-hour parking only.)

4) On Saturday, Lot 204 and Lot 310 near the College of Music are open to public for \$4 all day.
