Hailed by the American Academy of Art & Letters for music of "inexhaustible imagination, wit, expressive range and originality," composer Tom Cipullo is the winner of the 2016 Pellicciotti Opera Composition Prize from SUNY/Potsdam, a Guggenheim Fellowship, the Arts & Letters Award from the American Academy, and the Sylvia Goldstein Award from Copland House. 


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
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




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
