

OCU WINS 2 FIRSTS AT NOA PRODUCTION AWARDS; CHENOWETH APPOINTED ARTIST IN RESIDENCE

The Wanda L. Bass School of Music at Oklahoma City University offers outstanding vocalists a myriad of performance opportunities in chamber, choral, orchestral and theatrical settings including a six-show, 18-performance season with the nation's oldest collegiate-based opera and music theater company. OCU was honored with two first place NOA awards in the past season and named to *Playbill's* list of Big 10 Broadway schools for the second consecutive year. Top MM candidates are invited to apply for Graduate Performance Assistantships in Opera or Vocal Performance; undergraduates may double-major in music theater and vocal performance. Artist-in-Residence Kristin Chenoweth (OCU BM Music Theater '90, MM Opera Performance '92) mentors students on campus twice each semester.
