Recent information provided by Susan Yarnell-Monks, President of EVTA suggests that the following countries are actively pursuing the formation of voice teachers associations: Estonia, Lithuania and Portugal. Montenegro and Macedonia have made inquiries but so far no action has been taken toward forming an association.

There has been some intermittent contact with some conservatory teachers in Czech Republic, Slovakia and Greece, but to my knowledge nothing has been undertaken there in recent years to form any voice teacher assns. There is little english language information regarding vocal pedagogy in Russia, Belarus, and Ukraine. And in the former SSRs even less so. The current vocal pedagogy situations in Bosnia-Herzegovina, Albania, Romania and Bulgaria are little known to me and need to be researched.
