Your Teacher Profile information is PUBLIC and OPTIONAL. It will be displayed to anyone who searches for singing teachers on the Find A Teacher page. Only include details that you want the PUBLIC to see.

only displayed to active NATS members
who log in to the NATS website and click




The most important step in getting your profile found on the NATS Find A Teacher page is for you to manually Participate.


**KEY CONCEPT:** 

To increase the likelihood of getting found on the NATS Find A Teacher page, include as much information as possible. Because potential students can limit their search by state and city, it is essential to complete these in your profile, even though they are not required fields.




### **KEY CONCEPT:**

Your Profile photo is visible to the public only if you have selected Yes to Participate in your Teacher Profile, which allows people to find you on the NATS Find A Teacher pages.


